#### Treasurer's Column - From John Fischer

Before discussing the Club's financial performance so far this year, (which is progressing well), I would like to mention a few initiatives the Finance Committee and Board of Governors are considering as part of our ongoing strategic planning process, of which the Member survey this spring is an integral part.

One suggestion is to make the The Jeremy a cashless club. Many country clubs are cashless and it would be a small step toward enhancing exclusivity at The Jeremy, as well as streamlining back office accounting with our clubs limited office staff. Credit cards would still be allowed for purchases made in the golf shop, for both merchandise and guest fees, but Member and their guest charges in all food and beverage outlets would be required to be run through the Member's account. Cash would only be allowed for certain outside events, such as UGA golf tournaments or private functions (Member or non-Member) with cash (non-hosted) bars.

Another suggestion is to make The Jeremy a non-tipping club. The primary reason for this consideration is to eliminate a Member feeling compelled to reach in his or her pocket two or three times each visit to the club. We could implement this for the outside cart staff only or include the restaurant staff as well. There are many options to accomplish this. Two examples would be: 1) Raising the cart fee from \$12 to \$13 with the added dollar going into a pool to be split amongst the staff based on hours worked. 2) Establish a service fee amount to be billed to each Member at the beginning of each season; these funds would be used to compensate the staff at a higher hourly rate to compensate for their loss of tip revenue. We feel a more predictable compensation for the service staff within our Park City labor market will help us attract quality people, and promote a higher level of service.

If you have advice or opinions- (either positive or negative), please track down one of your Board Members and "bend their ears". E-mailing Board Members works well too – you can find all Board Member e-mail addresses on The Jeremy website (www.thejeremy.com). The Board would like to hear from you and include all Members comments in the discussion, before taking further initiative on these subjects.

As for the financials, through July 31 (the first seven months of our fiscal year), The Jeremy beat the budget by greater than \$21,000. The Golf Shop department is close to budget. The Grounds and Administration departments have outperformed budget, with the Restaurant below budget expectations.

Golf Shop merchandise sales are 15% ahead of last year through July and their profit margin on those sales has increased from 22% to 25%, a lot of this due to Heidi's efforts with non- Members whom do not receive our Member discount. Guest and cart fee revenue this year has exceeded budget and year to date activity of last year. In the Administration department, transfer fees (the \$5,000 we receive for each Membership sale) are \$180,000 to date. This is \$40,000 ahead of budgeted expectations, but \$40,000 less than last year through July.

The Restaurant department is showing a strong increase in revenue in banquets, dining room and the midmountain canteen. Overall Restaurant department revenues are 40% above last year at this time and slightly ahead of our aggressive budget, ( which anticipated increased restaurant usage due to the Member minimum increase made effective January 1, 2006). However, the costs of servicing this increased restaurant business have exceeded expectations, especially in the month of July. The 2006 Restaurant budget was based on the concept increased restaurant traffic will result in more operating efficiencies. This proved to work only to a point. Our kitchen size and clubhouse layout create problems and inefficiencies if we combine too many banquets combined with our usual busy season restaurant traffic. We plan to be more discriminating, including raising prices for certain kinds of plated functions, when scheduling future banquets especially in the month of July when both the ladies and men's Member- Guest tournaments take place.
