There was a clear mandate on June 7th regarding an assessment for the Range and Practice Area proposed improvements...NO. Even if all of those Members that did not vote (172) were to vote yes, the assessment would have still been a few votes short of the 2/3 required.

What isn't so clear is where the Board goes next. Was the Range Project voted down because it was considered a poor project? Too expensive? Would a partial Range improvement pass? Other preferred projects? Would any project brought in front of the Membership for assessment pass? Should we eliminate our debt service before considering any other assessments?

These will be Board discussion items in the following months. Your Board is attempting to be there for the Membership, but the path is not clear. Last year's Survey provided some insights, but not necessary the answers.

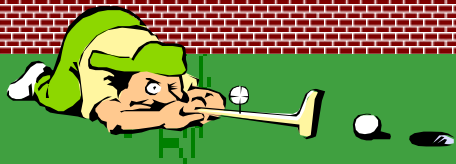

Summer is in full tilt here at The Jeremy. There are many fun social and golfing events scheduled for this July. The first golfing event of July will be ***Beat The Pro*** on Wednesday, July 4th. ***The Round Up*** is the clubs premiere men's event of the season and will be held Wednesday, July 11th through Saturday, July 14th. The membership will be able to play at any of the reciprocating clubs (Riverside, Ogden, Logan, Alpine, Willow Creek, Oakridge) on Thursday, July 12th through Saturday, July 14th for only cart fees.

The second ***Couples Golf Night*** will be held on Friday, July 20th. There will be an optional Glow Golf event after dinner. Dinner, golf, and a great time are guaranteed so sign up in the golf shop today.

The Ladies Association will be holding their ***Ladies Invitational*** starting with a cocktail party and derby on Thursday, July 26th, followed by the tournament on Friday, July 27th - Saturday, July 28th. This great annual event still has open spots, so sign up in the golf shop today.

Here are the Golf related hours through the summer months: ***Golf Shop*** Monday through Sunday 6:30am until 8:00pm ***Driving Range*** hours are 6:45am until 7:30pm Tuesday through Sunday and 1:30pm until 7:30pm on Mondays. Last but certainly not least, the golf course is open from 7:00am until dark seven days a week. Please check an activities calendar to see which Mondays hold corporate tournaments.

When practicing on the range there are a few items that we request you could follow. If you are not sure how to make a correct divot pattern please refer to the chart on the bag stand or ask one of our staff. In an effort to save as much turf as possible the club adopted a policy a few years ago that allows guests to hit range balls only on days when they are playing with a member. Appropriate attire will be worn on the practice facilities and golf course. Men must wear golf shirts with sleeves and golf slacks or medium length shorts. Tank tops, tee shirts, jeans, athletic shorts, etc. are not permissible. Women's shorts and/or golf skirts must be of medium length. Halters, mid-riffs, athletic shorts, short-shorts, and jeans are not permitted. *Juniors* are included in this Dress Code Policy. For those members who do not have bag tags please swing by the golf shop and we will gladly make one for you. When coming to practice or play, we ask that everyone please park in the parking lot and not on the street. When you see Jack on the first tee ask him about the five point repair tool inspection. Thank you for your compliance and support of these items regarding the practice facility.

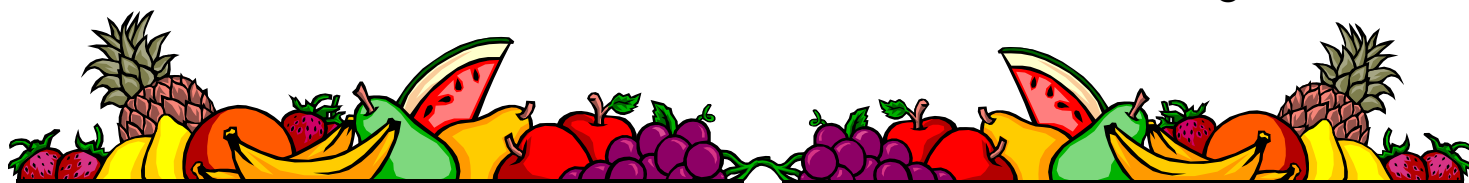

Jeremy Junior League - PGA Professional Adrian DeJesus

Great news... We are starting a “Junior League” on Wednesday evenings with starting tee times beginning between 6:00 and 6:30 pm. The following are the parameters of each Wednesday session. We need the support of as many juniors as we can get to participate. We also need a list of parents to volunteer and ride along and supervise each group. Please call the golf shop to SET UP TEE TIMES and to sign up on the volunteer list. We are hoping to get enough parents to need volunteers once a month only. This is an important first step to starting a strong junior program at the Jeremy and I urge you to participate with your juniors.

Wednesday Night Junior League (Open to all juniors)

1. Starting times between 6:00 and 6:30 pm
2. Ages 6-10 (yellow tags) must be accompanied by parent or chaperone.
3. Ages 10-14 (red tags) are permitted to walk and play with out parents; however they will be marshaled by volunteers. Parents, of course, are allowed to join them.
4. All ages on Wednesday night will be encouraged to play from the junior card, i.e. par 4's 150 yards, par 5's 200 yards. Par 3's from red tees. This will help the pace of play. Older players and more skilled players may play from the red tees.
5. P.G.A. Golf Professional Adrian DeJesus will be Starter/ Ranger/Director.
 - a. Several parents have volunteered to help Marshall/ supervise; we need more help, please get your name on the volunteer list.
 - b. Rules will be established. i.e.:
 - i. No child will ever be allowed to drive a golf cart at anytime.
 - ii. Pace of play will be strictly enforced, 6 ball rule will be in effect.



Adrian will also “float around” during the league play so he can watch, praise, and give quick coaching tips where/when necessary to kids he sees playing. He'll even, at times, play a few holes with the kids and then switch groups to play with other kids. One of the major points of this program is to build quality camaraderie amongst our junior players and have them understand a little fun in “group play”.

This format will also help our juniors who are a bit more serious about the game prepare themselves for the “Junior Club Championship”, that is held at the end of each summer. Hopefully, by encouraging our juniors to play in the junior league, the Junior Club Championship will build and become a very meaningful championship for our juniors. Also, it is our goal to have our junior players represent The Jeremy both as players and as ambassadors of the game. The junior league will also help our junior players learn the rules of the game as well as proper speed of play and etiquette. 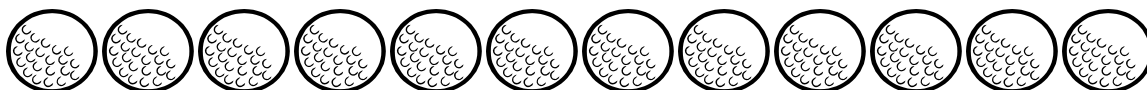
