Thanks in advance for your continued support, and as always, if there is anything I can do to make your visits to the club more enjoyable, you have only to ask.

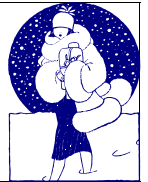

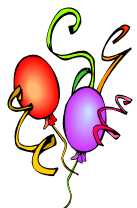
