



MESSAGE FROM THE PRESIDENT

I hope you are all enjoying the new carts that were recently delivered. I have heard many favorable comments about them – even the color (pumpkin? cayenne? burnt orange?). I thought I would spend a moment explaining how these new carts came about. Our prior golf carts were on a 4-year lease expiring at the end of March 2009. Ellen Artist, Board member and Treasurer, and Eric Frady, Controller, started pre-planning about the financial effects of lease termination/settlement. In communicating with the distributor of our Club Car carts, they came back to us with a proposal to take back the old carts and give us new ones now versus waiting until next Spring. Ellen and Eric ran the numbers numerous ways and always reached the same conclusion – we would be crazy not to pursue their proposal. Apparently the distributor's business is slow and they were highly motivated to move new carts. Then Rick Schaefer, out GM, did a wonderful job negotiating even further concessions from the distributor and the Board moved to approve the new 4-year cart lease at our May 29 meeting.

These new carts are quite similar to our prior ones, except for battery system upgrade, improved suspension, better and quieter canopy mounting and updated computer control chips regulating braking and governors – not to mention the color and added mounted coolers. I personally feel that Club Car carts are easily superior to the golf carts I've ridden on from other manufacturers. Kudos to Ellen, Rick and Eric for getting us in these new carts in a surprisingly cost effective manner.

With these new carts, it is time to remind all of you to please keep them off the parking lot. We have all gotten in the habit at the end of a round, while coming off the 18th green driving back to the clubhouse, to completely ignore the big sign pointing *left* for cart return. We turn *right* and go to the parking lot to unload where carts are susceptible to getting scraped and dinged, not to mention the congestion created.

Congratulations to Nate Roberts, our 2008 Jeremy Cup champion with rounds of 75-73 = 148. As well as being a World Cup freestyle mogul skier, he is also quite the golfer. Also congratulations to the other gross and net winners in the championship, first and second flights: Rick Bregger, Scott Benson, Lester Chang, Kurt Matz, John Harris and Mark Pennells. Job well done!

Summer is in full tilt here at The Jeremy. There are many fun social and golfing events scheduled for this July.

The first golfing event of July will be **Beat The Pro**, on Friday, July 4th. Try your net score against Tom's gross score. Minimum wagers are \$10 and the maximum will be \$100. If you happen to beat the Pro, you can win your bet amount in the way of golf shop merchandise.

The Round Up is the club's premiere men's event of the season and will be held Wednesday, July 16th through Saturday, July 19th. The membership will be able to play at any of the reciprocating clubs (Riverside, Ogden, Logan, Alpine, Willow Creek, Oakridge) on Thursday, July 17th through Saturday, July 19th for only cart fees.

The second **Couples Golf Night** will be held on Friday, July 25th. Dinner, golf, and a great time are guaranteed, so sign up in the golf shop today.

The Ladies Association will be holding the **River Run's Through It** on Thursday, July 31st through Saturday, August 2nd. This great annual invitational event still has open spots, so sign up in the golf shop today.

Here is the Golf related hours through the summer months: **Golf Shop** Monday through Sunday 6:30am until 8:00pm **Driving Range** hours are 6:45am until 8:00pm Tuesday through Sunday and 1:30pm until 8:00pm on Mondays. Last but certainly not least, the golf course is open from 7:00am until dark seven days a week. Corporate tournaments are held every Monday through the middle of September.

When practicing on the range there are a few items that we request you could follow. If you are not sure how to make a correct divot pattern please refer to the chart on the bag stand or ask one of our staff. In an effort to save as much turf as possible the club adopted a policy a few years ago that allows guests to hit range balls only on days when they are playing with a member. Appropriate attire will be worn on the practice facilities and golf course. Men must wear golf shirts with sleeves and golf slacks or medium length shorts. Tank tops, tee shirts, jeans, athletic shorts, etc. are not permissible. Women's shorts and/or golf skirts must be of medium length. Halters, mid-riffs, athletic shorts, short-shorts, and jeans are not permitted. *Juniors* are included in this Dress Code Policy. For those members who do not have bag tags please swing by the golf shop and we will gladly make one for you. When coming to practice or play, we ask that everyone please park in the parking lot and not on the street. Thank you for your compliance and support of these items regarding the practice facility.

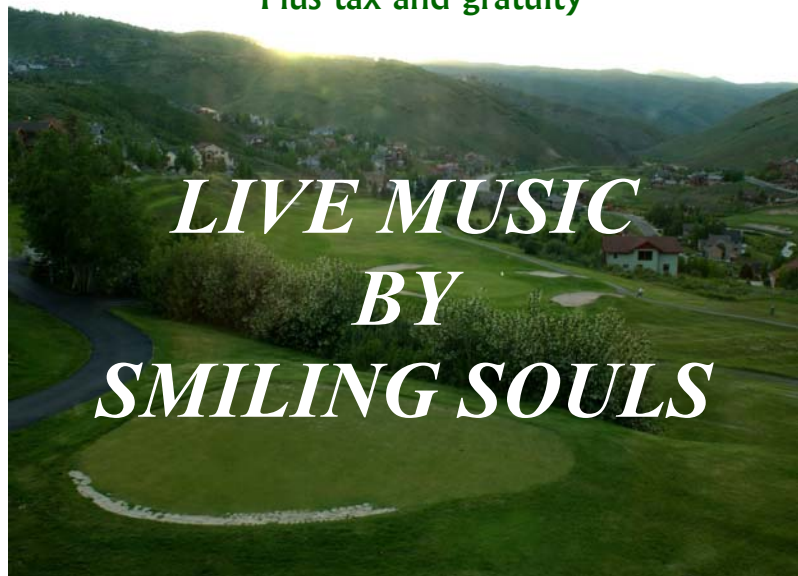

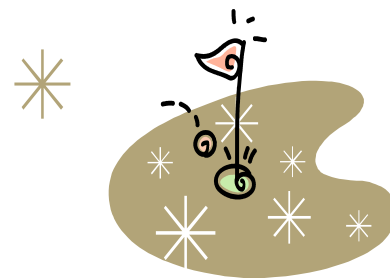

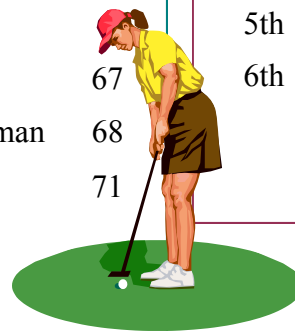
