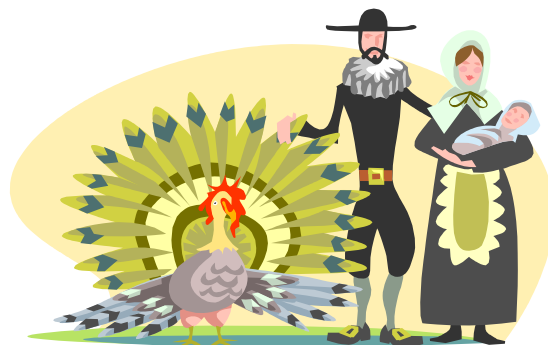

Remember that all member appreciation guest rounds will expire at the end of the 2009 golf season. Please check with the golf shop to make sure you have used your round.

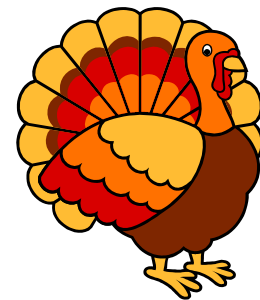
### **POLICY CHANGE GOLF SHOP SWEEPS / STORE CREDIT**

### Important Dates To Remember For The Round Up

#### **Friday, May 14, 2010**

If you played last year, this is the deadline date for entering this years tournament. You must turn in the official entry form to the golf shop. Official entry forms will be mailed in March for 2010.

#### **May 15, 2010 - June 14, 2010**

If you are on the waiting list and a spot becomes available and you choose not to play in 2010, you will lose your spot on the wait list and you must sign up again with the General Manager if you want to play in the future.

#### **Tuesday, June 15, 2010**

The last day you may drop out of the tournament without being billed for the cost of the tournament (beyond this date, the following applies). If we are able to fill your spot you will be billed \$100.00. If we are unable to find a replacement you will be billed 100% of the entry fee.

If you drop out of the tournament on or after this date for a non-exemptible reason, you will lose your slot the following year unless you pay this season's event entry fee. If you are on the waiting list and a position becomes available, you have the option to play or pass. If you choose to pass you will retain your position on the waiting list.
