I have met many of you, still working on those names, and look forward to meeting those of you I have not! I am very excited to join such a wonderful team here at The Jeremy and look forward to continuing to elevate The Jeremy Golf & Country Club.

October is a busy month here at Jeremy. As the end of the season quickly approaches, Tom Rhoades is starting to prepare the course for the upcoming winter and finish a few projects before Mother Nature closes us down for the season! Shortly, you will start seeing Tom and the crew working to reconstruct two greens, greenside bunker on #2 and the smaller fairway bunker on the right of #9. We will be removing all the sand, reworking the drainage system and replacing with clean sand. Once work begins, these two bunkers will be considered G.U.R. On October 14<sup>th</sup> and 15<sup>th</sup>, Tom and his staff will be blowing out the irrigation system to prevent our pipes from freezing. If you end up playing one of these two days, please be aware that sprinkler heads around the golf course will be popping on and off randomly! Tom will also be applying a Snow Mold Fungicide on Wednesday, October 16<sup>th</sup> which will unfortunately necessitate the closure of the golf course for that day. Other preparations for the upcoming winter include: Installing more elk fences, cutting drains in tees and greens to drain surface water to reduce the chance of ice buildup.

The golf course is scheduled to be open through November 17<sup>th</sup>, unless Mother Nature has different plans this year. Jake and the golf staff is defiantly hoping for a long fall season. Be sure to stop by the golf shop and use all that banked credit book! Jake has some great sales going on this fall and remember, you can always special order items for the upcoming holiday season!

Don't forget about all our upcoming events: Friday Night Entertainment, October 25<sup>th</sup> and November 1<sup>st</sup>, Kids Halloween Party, Saturday October 26<sup>th</sup>, our 1<sup>st</sup> Annual Adult Halloween Party, Saturday, October 26<sup>th</sup> and Meet the Candidates on Friday, November 1<sup>st</sup>. From Grounds Committee ~ Stuart Lambert

It's amazing how fast this summer went and quickly fall arrived. With our first glimpse of winter, we received over six inches of snow the first week of October. In preparing for winter, we have several projects that we'll be working in order to get ready for the 2014 golf season.

The Grounds Team has already completed aerification of the golf course, trimmed back the willows on 16, and put up the electric fences around the greens to keep the elk and moose off of the greens. Over the next few weeks, they'll be blowing the sprinklers out on October 14<sup>th</sup> & 15<sup>th</sup> and working on redoing two of the bunkers, as stated in the business plan (second bunker on the right hand side of number 9 and the front right greenside bunker of number 2). Our goal over the next several years is to redo at least two bunkers each year. At a cost of roughly eight thousand for a normal sized bunker, we cannot address all of the bunkers in 2013 & 2014, but have identified alternative grooming technics to improve the conditions of the bunkers until we've had a chance to redo them.

Other projects slated for next spring include fixing the driving range wall. The current wall is separating from the foundation and poses a safety hazard. In addition, the mats are close to the putting green, making it a potential hazard for those putting on the green. The Grounds Committee is currently reviewing two options. The first option is replacing the current wall and keeping the existing setup. The cost to replace the existing wall is roughly \$10,000. The second option is remove the existing wall and creating a slope between the putting green and the second level of the driving range. This option would include a built in matt that would stretch across the driving range, approximately 8' wide by 110' long. This matt would be at the base of the slope, thus expanding the practice tee and creating a separation between the putting green and the practice matts. The Grounds Committee is currently obtaining quotes to remove the existing wall, slope the hill and installing the matt. One thing to note is that the club spends approximately \$2,000 per year to replace existing matts and with option two, the life span is about 10 years.

Other items discussed in the past Grounds Committee meeting are creating an intermediate cut, sculpting of fairways and planting of trees along number 13. After reviewing the height of the fairways and rough, the difference between the two would be only three quarters of an inch. In addition, we would have to purchase a new machine at \$25,000 dedicated to mow the intermediate rough areas plus allocate an additional six to ten hours of labor per week. The Grounds Committee decided that it would not be in the best interest of the club at this time.

Earlier this year, we reviewed what it would take to "sculpt" fairways to add to the aesthetics of the golf course and playability for the higher handicap players. At that time, we indicated that we would address it again this fall. As a result of our past meeting and a recommendation from Landscapes Unlimited, the Grounds Committee agreed that it would best to address sculpting of the fairways first thing next season. The reason why we didn't address and take action this year is the timing in which the process took place and upcoming tournaments. Sculpting of fairways involves dropping the mowing height a quarter of an inch until we reach the desired height. As a result, we will "scalp" the grass, leaving it brown until it has a chance to grow back.

Lastly, it was asked of the committee to review planting of trees along 13 fairway to protect players on hole twelve. For those members that can remember, we used to have trees along 13, however, due to drainage issues and wildlife, the trees either suffered from too much water or were consumed by moose and other wild life. The trees would have to be large enough to survive these conditions and survive aggressive wildlife. The Grounds Committee has decided not to proceed at this time due to the cost associated with planting large trees and irrigation challenges.

Please note, that we are scheduled to close the golf course for the season on November 17<sup>th</sup>, weather permitting. Please continue to check Jeremy's Facebook page for updates on course conditions.
